

## Scriptures to Encourage You

### **Jeremiah 30:12-13, 17**

12 “This is what the LORD says: Yours is an incurable bruise, a terrible wound. 13 There is no one to help you or bind up your injury. You are beyond the help of any medicine.

17 I will give you back your health and heal your wounds, says the LORD.

### **Matthew 8:3, 7, 13**

3 Jesus touched him. “I want to,” he said. “Be healed!” And instantly the leprosy disappeared.

7 Jesus said, “I will come and heal him.”

13 Then Jesus said to the Roman officer, “Go on home. What you have believed has happened.” And the young servant was healed that same hour.

### **Psalms 118:17-18**

17 I will not die, but I will live to tell what the LORD has done. 18 The LORD has punished me severely, but he has not handed me over to death.

### **Deuteronomy 30:19-20**

19 “Today I have given you the choice between life and death, between blessings and curses. I call on heaven and earth to witness the choice you make. Oh, that you would choose life, that you and your descendants might live! 20 Choose to love the LORD your God and to obey him and commit yourself to him, for he is your life. Then you will live long in the land the LORD swore to give your ancestors Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.”

### **Psalms 126:3**

3 Yes, the LORD has done amazing things for us! What joy!

### **Psalms 30:1-3, 5, 8-12**

1 I will praise you, LORD, for you have rescued me. You refused to let my enemies triumph over me. 2 O LORD my God, I cried out to you for help, and you restored my health.

3 You brought me up from the grave, O LORD.

You kept me from falling into the pit of death.

5 His anger lasts for a moment, but his favor lasts a lifetime! Weeping may go on all night, but joy comes with the morning.

8 I cried out to you, O LORD. I begged the Lord for mercy, saying, 9 “What will you gain if I die, if I sink down into the grave? Can my dust praise you from the grave? Can it tell the world of your faithfulness? 10 Hear me, LORD, and have mercy on me. Help me, O LORD.” 11 You have turned my mourning into joyful dancing. You have taken away my clothes of mourning and clothed me with joy, 12 that I might sing praises to you and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give you thanks forever!

#### **Psalm 18:1-6**

1 I love you, LORD; you are my strength. 2 The LORD is my rock, my fortress, and my savior; my God is my rock, in whom I find protection. He is my shield, the strength of my salvation, and my stronghold. 3 I will call on the LORD, who is worthy of praise, for he saves me from my enemies. 4 The ropes of death surrounded me; the floods of destruction swept over me.

5 The grave wrapped its ropes around me; death itself stared me in the face. 6 But in my distress I cried out to the LORD; yes, I prayed to my God for help. He heard me from his sanctuary; my cry reached his ears.

#### **Psalm 21:1-4**

1 How the king rejoices in your strength, O LORD! He shouts with joy because of your victory. 2 For you have given him his heart's desire;

you have held back nothing that he requested. 3 You welcomed him back with success and prosperity. You placed a crown of finest gold on his head. 4 He asked you to preserve his life, and you have granted his request. The days of his life stretch on forever.

#### **Psalm 22:20-22**

20 Rescue me from a violent death; spare my precious life from these dogs. 21 Snatch me from the lions' jaws, and from the horns of these wild oxen. 22 Then I will declare the wonder of your name to my brothers and sisters. I will praise you among all your people.

**Psalm 91:1-4, 14-16**

1 Those who live in the shelter of the Most High will find rest in the shadow of the Almighty. 2 This I declare of the LORD: He alone is my refuge, my place of safety; he is my God, and I am trusting him. 3 For he will rescue you from every trap and protect you from the fatal plague. 4 He will shield you with his wings. He will shelter you with his feathers. His faithful promises are your armor and protection.

14 The LORD says, "I will rescue those who love me. I will protect those who trust in my name. 15 When they call on me, I will answer; I will be with them in trouble. I will rescue them and honor them. 16 I will satisfy them with a long life and give them my salvation."

**Psalm 92:5**

5 O LORD, what great miracles you do! And how deep are your thoughts.

2 Corinthians 1:4, 11

4 He comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others. When others are troubled, we will be able to give them the same comfort God has given us.

11 He will rescue us because you are helping by praying for us. As a result, many will give thanks to God because so many people's prayers for our safety have been answered.

**Psalm 119:92-93**

92 If your law hadn't sustained me with joy, I would have died in my misery. 93 I will never forget your commandments, for you have used them to restore my joy and health.
